Tab 1: Approval of the February 24, 2015 Meeting Minutes

Tab 3: PERS Medical Re-Certification

Mr. Lynch made a motion to discontinue Jerry A. Lowe's PERS disability annuity effective May 1, 2015 until he complies with submission of a physician's report stating he remains disabled. If an appropriate medical re-certification form is received within 1 year, staff will be authorized to reinstate his annuity, effective the first day of the month following receipt. If refusal continues for 1 year, his annuity shall be terminated. The motion was seconded by Mr. Fletcher. The motion carried unanimously.

Chairman Murray asked the Committee if there was any other business to bring before the Disability Committee. None was heard.

Mr. Fletcher made a motion to adjourn the Disability Committee Meeting. Captain Corsaro seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
